Then, trade island for island as you ferry to **Krabi**, your home, for your final four nights. Pick up the pace with a speedboat trip to **Hong Island** and embark on a personalized adventure, complete with a picnic lunch, before spending your final day relaxing on **Krabi Beach**. Say your goodbyes and end your trip with a transfer to Phuket Airport.
