Day 1 – Arrival Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

On arrival at Kuala Lumpur International airport and proceed for the immigration. After clearing your immigration & customs proceed to the exit gate, here you will be met by the TPI chauffeur, holding a placard displaying guest name. Please look for him. The chauffeur will escort you to the Kuala Lumpur hotel.

Situated in the heart of southeast Asia, Malaysia is a tropical paradise full of variation and surprises. Bustling towns, pristine beaches, and lush rainforests make Malaysia a fascinating and somewhat underrated destination. Besides the breath-taking nature, what makes Malaysia truly unique is the cultural diversity, which is prevalent in the culture and cuisine all over the country. If you want to explore the whole nation, you'll have to spend at least 1-2 months in Malaysia.

Day 2 – City tour of Kuala Lumpur

Discover the modern and colonial architecture of Kuala Lumpur on a half-day tour, and marvel at attractions from the upscale shopping mall of the Petronas Twin Towers to the one-of-a-kind street markets. Continue to the King's Palace (Istana Negara) and take pictures of the intricate royal residence. Contrast the glass and steel marvels of the city center with the manicured grounds of the National Mosque and its dome of blue and green tiles. Pay your respects to those who lost their lives in the struggle for independence at Tugu Negara. Visit the Sultan Abdul Samad Building and Chocolate Shop, where you can purchase exquisite chocolates.

During the tour, photo stop at the Petronas Twin Towers, King's Palace, National Monument, National Museum and National Mosque. NOTE: The itinerary is subject to change based on weather or traffic conditions of the day.

Rest of the day will be free to explore on your own to visit the local markets, shopping malls etc.

Day 3 – Day trip to Genting Highlands

Escape the heat of Kuala Lumpur city center and head for the cool mountain air of Malaysia's casino resort. Pick-up from your hotel, journey to the cable car station at Genting Highlands and take the skyway cable car over the tropical rainforest. Try your luck at blackjack, roulette or other casino games, or choose to enjoy recreational facilities at the indoor theme park. Brave the rollercoasters or the only sky diving simulator in Asia. End the day with a shopping spree at over 80 boutique stores. Then, return to Kuala Lumpur via the Hindu shrines of Batu Caves, where steps up the mountain are guarded by a golden statue of Murugan.

Day 4 – Kuala Lumpur Departure

Time to say Good Bye!! In time you will be transferred from your hotel to the Kuala Lumpur departure terminal to board the flight to back home. Tour Ends

Extension Trip to Malacca City -

After a Kuala Lumpur hotel pick-up, you can relax in a comfortable, air-conditioned coach that will transfer you for a full day of sightseeing in Malacca City, on the Malay Peninsula's southwest coast. The tour begins with a visit to the Stadthuys, a historic landmark structure located in the heart of Malacca City, on the Red Square. Then take in a panoramic view of the city and surrounding region from the top of St. Paul's Hill, which features the historic St. Paul's Church, the oldest church building in South-East Asia, and part of the Malacca Museum Complex. After a break for lunch (at your own expense), follow the guide to Jonker Street, the center of Chinatown. Once renowned for its antique shops, Jonker Street now features clothing and craft outlets as well as restaurants. Finally, visit the A Famosa fortress, which is among the oldest surviving European architectural remains in South-East Asia, and stop at Cheng Hoon Teng, a Chinese temple practicing the Three Doctrinal Systems of Taoism, Confucianism and Buddhism. The tour ends with a return trip to Kuala Lumpur.

Extension Trip to Cameron Highlands

Embark on a day tour from Kuala Lumpur to the Cameron Highlands, a haven for nature enthusiasts featuring cool weather and stunning natural landscapes. Discover the area's architectural heritage with visits to several farms on a private or shared tour.

After pickup at your hotel in Kuala Lumpur, set off toward the Cameron Highlands with your guide. Make your first stop at the Lata Iskandar Waterfall and enjoy this highlight for nature enthusiasts. Next, experience the serenity of the Cameron Valley Plantation, where you can enjoy fresh tea and buy various tea products, ride buggy or walk in the middle of tea plantation. Continue your journey into local life at Kea Farm, where you can also purchase fresh produce from the local market. Move on to a strawberry farm to handpick your own strawberries and take some photos, then head to Flora Park to take breath taking beautiful pictures. Discover the region's diversity with further visits to bee farm, butterfly park, and also cactus farm. After a day's getaway, drive back to Kuala Lumpur for drop-off at your hotel.

NOTE: Entrance fees will be paid directly at the various farms and the buggy service. At the Strawberry park - strawberry plucking will be extra charges.

It has two parts: Penang Island, where the capital city, George Town, is located, and Seberang Perai on the Malay Peninsula. Extension Trip to Langkawi

Langkawi, officially known as Langkawi, the Jewel of Kedah, is a duty-free island and an archipelago of 99 islands (plus five small islands visible only at low tide in the Strait of Malacca) located some 30 km off the coast of northwestern Malaysia and a few kilometres south of Ko Tarutao, adjacent to the Thai border. The island is surrounded by the Andaman Sea and offers a mixture of picturesque paddy fields, jungle-clad hills, and tranquil waterfalls. Pantai Cenang is the island's most popular beach and tourist area.

Langkawi, one of Malaysia's most picturesque areas has been designated as a UNESCO Global Geopark, Southeast Asia's first. This cluster of 99 islands offers beautiful beaches, world-class infrastructure, ultra-cheap duty-free shopping and fascinating myths and legends. Explore this amazing part of the world as you want to on this private guided tour.
