Day 1: Casablanca Airport - Casablanca

Marhaba! Welcome to Morocco! a land of tolerance, openness and hospitality. A country with a big history, rich culture, art, food, architecture and variety of landscapes from mountains, coastlines to the fascinating desert. Today, your private expert driver & guide will be waiting for you at the entrance of the airport to transfer you to your hotel for overnight.

Day 2: Casablanca - Meknes - Volubilis - Fes

After breakfast, we will visit the stunning Hassan 2 mosque, then make our way to Meknes, a city with a 17th century heritage and one of the four imperial cities of Morocco. We stop here

















for lunch which is at own expense and hang out at the historical huge walls of the medina and Bab El Mansour Gate, one of the most attractive historical gates in Morocco. We will leave Meknes behind and take the short journey to the Roman settlement of Volubilis for a guided tour; it is the largest ancient attraction in Morocco and is a UNESCO listed site dating back to AD 40. We then move on to Fes tonight.

Day 3: Fes

Fes is the oldest and largest medieval city in the world and its medina is a cacophony of aromas, sights and sounds. This morning, we enjoy a guided tour of Fes el Bali - the old walled city. This fascinating medina is a veritable rabbit warren of 9400 alleys that often finish with dead ends – so be sure to stay close to the group! We also visit the dye-pits and tanneries before lunch in the medina. The remainder1of the day is at leisure. You have the option for a classic dinner (at own cost) and live Moroccan entertainment, including traditional music, belly dancing and magicians.

Day 4: Fes - Chefchaouen

After breakfast we drive towards Chefchaouen (bleu city) that is a Morocco popular tourist attraction and welcoming town situated in the Rif Mountains just south of the Mediterranean coastline in northwest Morocco. This nice bleu city is known for its traditional buildings. Enjoy a walk to explore the white and blue washed walls of the medina and the markets that offer some unique native handicrafts. Chefchaouen is a fantastic destination for photography with its wonderful views of the Rif Mountains. We will have dinner in one of the local restaurants in the medina before returning back to our hotel. Overnight in Chefchaouen

Day 5: Chefchaouen- Rabat- Casablanca

After breakfast we travel south to the official capital of Morocco, Rabat. On arrival, we will go on a guided tour of Rabat and its major landmarks such as the Hassan tower and the Mausoleum of the Alaouite King Mohamed V and his son Hassan II. Afterwards, we visit the Oudaya Kasbah, a fortified building that used to be a place to defend the city from the invasion of the European countries. After an optional lunch in Rabat, we leave for Casablanca for our last evening.

Day 6: Morocco Departure

Your adventure in Morocco comes to an end after breakfast, your transfer to Casablanca airport is at your disposal at any time of the day.
